

# Time to Apply for REFCO's Scholarships

The REFCO Board has voted to award two \$2,000 Anna B. Lund Memorial Scholarships to eligible students attending CSUF and one \$1,000 scholarship to an eligible student at Fresno City College for the 2019-20 school year. The application deadline is March 2, 2019 for CSUF and March 4, 2019 for FCC.

Students need to complete a new scholarship application every year because their status might change, such as a change in their major, grade point

average, number of units/classes, etc. They must answer "yes" in the check box asking if they are a child, grandchild, or great grandchild of a REFCO member.

A General Selection Committee from each school has the responsibility of reviewing all applications and selecting the potential scholarship winners.

Once a student has been selected for the scholarship, they receive a written notification of the award prior to the start
